Abstract Submission, Selection, Paper Submission and Oral/Poster Presentation

Abstract (less than 300 words) should be submitted to the technical committee not later than July 20, 2024. The abstract should be with presentation type (oral or poster), title, name of author(s) (both in English and Japanese), affiliation, grade (B4/M1/M2/D), gender and e-mail address. Limited number of papers will be accepted after selection by the technical committee. Final camera-ready paper for publication in the proceedings (A4 size up to 4 pages including figures and tables) must be received by the technical committee as a PDF file not later than September 20, 2024. Oral presentation should last no longer than 10 minutes to allow 5 minutes for questions and changeover to the next speaker. The size of poster may be up to 841mm × 1189mm (A0 size). Abstract and paper should be e-mailed to the technical committee (ismai@meiji.ac.jp).
